## INFORMATION ABOUT THE HIKES

### The Hikes:

**The McCall Hiking Club** organizes hikes in June through September on Tuesdays and Saturdays. Beginners through advanced hikers are welcome. Transportation will be provided by car-pooling, or, occasionally, by City of McCall Recreation van. A \$4 to \$6 donation is recommended to offset transportation costs.

Hikes are graded in a flexible standard. Each hiker must assess and accept responsibility for his/her own capability and fitness for any hike. The levels of the hikes include:

Round Trip	<u>Elevation Gain</u>	<u>Miles Distance</u>
Easy	0-400 ft.	1-4 miles
Intermediate	401-1000 ft.	4-7 miles
Advanced	1001-2500 ft.	7+ miles

### Schedules:

Hiking schedules, as well as social events, are discussed at monthly meetings scheduled after either Tuesday or Saturday hikes. All members are welcome! Notice about these meetings and the schedules will be sent out via e-mail newsletter, the web site and/or at hikes.

Members are also encouraged to make suggestions that would improve the club's operations. Hikes and social events are also published in the McCall Star News.

### Hike Leaders:

The McCall Hiking Club leaders are usually experienced hikers, but all members are encouraged to lead a hike(s). Call Roberta Thompson at 208-634-7465 if you have any ideas for a hike or would like to be a hike leader.

### What to Know About the Hikes:

The hikes are generally full-day hikes (returning to the parking lot at around 4 p.m.). If you need to leave the hike early, please bring your own vehicle. No dogs or small children are allowed on hikes (exceptions may be overnight trips).

### What to Bring On the Hikes:

The McCall Hiking Club encourages hikers to wear hiking boots or hiking shoes (tennis shoes are not recommended). Also, bring water (at least two 16 oz. bottles), food (lunch and/or snacks), sunscreen, insect spray and a whistle. We also encourage hikers to bring a clean change of shoes for traveling to and from trailheads and an extra bottle of water to leave in the van or car. It is each hiker's responsibility to see that he/she is adequately equipped for the hike.

### Scenic Hikes:

The McCall Hiking Club offers "scenic hikes." No change in meeting place or time. Scenic hikes are four miles or less, have very little elevation gain, are a slower pace and should be in a three hour time frame. Most hikes will be in close proximity to McCall and have interesting locations. Bring a snack and water. Scenic hike schedules will be dependent on demand and on hike leader availability.

### Special Events:

The McCall Hiking Club also engages in social and outdoor camping activities. These activities include picnics, barbecues, boat outings, and special hikes. If you would like to host a special event or have an idea, call Roberta Thompson.
